What's Happening...and how you can help

B.E.S.T. Concert Series - Each year GAHA brings celebrated national and international talent to the area. Our B.E.S.T. Committee scouts talent, handles performance logistics, schedules ushers, and assists with publicity and promotion.

B.E.S.T. for Kids - GAHA supports arts education in our schools by presenting groups designed to enrich the lives of the Gilmer County young people. Volunteers represent GAHA at these events, coordinate with performing groups, and assist with publicity and promotion.

CoffeeHouses - Our CoffeeHouse events are a local favorite! Come and join us for an evening of freshly baked desserts, hot coffee, tea and live music. Volunteers scout talent and coordinate the event, including bringing desserts and hosting.

Picnics by the River - Summertime is the season for our Picnic by the River events which feature live music. These events feature live music. Volunteers assist with making recommendations and booking talent, promoting the event, and with logistics at the Pavilion.

Supper Club - These events were just added to the GAHA calendar last year. We provide a hot catered dinner at GAHA with entertainment. Last year's events included a movie and a night with Sherlock Holmes.

Community Theatre - GAHA works with local theatre groups to present theatrical performances.

Community Chorus - The Community Chorus unites area singers in a variety of musical productions.

Gallery Shows and Events - GAHA has a series of events for artists interested in showcasing their work in Gilmer County. Receptions are held at the premiere of each gallery show. Volunteers assist with receiving and hanging art work as well as hosting and providing refreshments. Artists or others who can volunteer to staff the gallery on Saturdays, or help with logistics, are always needed.

Fundraising Events - The annual May Auction, the fall Attic Sale, and the Wine Tasting are GAHA's primary fundraising events. Volunteers work on committees that, among other things, coordinate a specific event, including promotion and publicity, finding donations, setting up and hosting the event and arranging for decorations and refreshments. Memberships, Sponsorships, Office Help, and Publicity - GAHA welcomes help for adhoc events and projects and calls upon volunteers as needed for membership outreach, writing articles or grant proposals, assisting office staff with bulk mailings and covering the office for short periods.
